**TUITION AND FEES COSTS
FOR THE DOCTOR OF MINISTRY PROGRAM**

Beginning in Summer Term 2010, and extending through at least the Spring Term 2011, costs for the D.Min. Program are as follows:

TUITION:

<u>Introductory Seminar</u> - 6 credit hrs.	\$1,185
<u>Elective Courses</u> - 18 credit hrs. at \$436 per hour*	\$7,848
<u>D.Min. Practicum</u> - 6 credit hrs.	\$887
<u>D.Min. Project</u> - 6 credit hrs.	<u>\$1,185</u>

FEES:

<u>Thesis binding fee for 2 copies</u>	\$50
<u>Graduation fee</u>	\$150
<u>Annual student fee</u> (\$50 per year for 4 years totaling)	<u>\$200</u>

TOTAL (36 credit hours & fees) **\$ 11,505**

These expenses are typically spread over four years. A course is paid for as it is taken, with payment made to the Business Office by the first day of the class. It is common for students to bring a check for the course tuition amount to campus to be dropped off at the Business Office the first day of class. CTS D.MIN. COSTS OTHER THAN TUITION & FEES

The other basic categories of expense are travel, room, board/food, and books. These expenses vary greatly depending on how far people travel, whether they can stay with friends, family, colleagues, or commute during courses at CTS, etc.

Harrington Center housing on campus is currently \$32 per night double occupancy or \$49 per night for a single room. Meals at the refectory are approximately \$5.25 breakfast, \$6.50 lunch, and \$7.25 dinner, with the option of cooking for yourself, using one of the two Harrington Center kitchens. An estimate of the cost of books per course is \$90, but that varies widely.
