

## Korean Immigrant Women's Leadership Education Certificate Program

Leadership. As women, all of us go through our lives exercising some form of leadership – as mothers, as organizers of family gatherings, as business associates and in other capacities. As church women, we also contribute greatly to the life and

ministry of the church. While the Korean church is beginning to acknowledge women's leadership, Korean women often find themselves in their leadership roles without much training. This is new territory for the Korean church to explore. Acknowledging this, National Korean Presbyterian Women, in partnership with Columbia Theological Seminary's Center for Lifelong Learning, is offering a Korean Immigrant Women's Leadership Education Certificate program.

### ***For whom is this program being offered?***

The program is being offered primarily for the Korean-speaking immigrant women who live within driving distance from Columbia Theological Seminary (CTS). All first-generation Korean immigrant women who would like to grow in their capacity as leaders in the church are encouraged to attend. All classes will begin at 7 p.m. on Friday and end by 5 p.m. on Saturday. CTS has guest housing on campus.

# C O L U M B I A T H E O L O G I C A L S E M I N A R Y

### ***Why enroll in this program?***

Participants in the program will gain a deeper understanding of leadership as a spiritual practice and the important role that women have to play as leaders within the Korean church. Courses will provide opportunities for women to connect with and empower one another for the sake of God's mission and ministry. Through worship, lectures, small group conversations, and individual reflections, participants will gain practical skills, spiritual insights, and theological learning to

equip them as leaders within the church.

### ***How does this program work?***

The program will consist of six courses, three offered in the Fall 2011 Series and three in the Spring 2011 Series. Each series will start with a beginning retreat, and each course will open and close with worship. Separate registration for each three-course series is required, and participants may register for the Spring Series even if they have not participated in the Fall Series.

Course leadership includes seminary faculty, denominational staff, and other women and men, clergy and lay. Those who complete both series will receive a certificate of completion from Columbia Theological Seminary.

### ***What does this program cost?***

Tuition is \$100 per person per three-course series. Program fees are kept low because of the generous subsidy of the National Korean Presbyterian Women.

Housing and meals are available at additional cost. Meals can be purchased on campus. We may also provide meals for which the group will share the cost. Housing on the seminary campus is \$49 per night plus tax, single occupancy, if available; \$32 per night, plus tax, double occupancy. (Rates current May, 2011)
