We hope that our Annual Impact Report will help you see how they flourish and that you will experience some of the same joy we encounter daily at Columbia.

## THE STRATEGIC BLUEPRINT GUIDING COLUMBIA INTO ITS THIRD CENTURY

In 2022-2023 academic year, President Aloyo kicked off the development of a new strategic blueprint to continue to nurture imaginative leaders for the Church and the world. Informed by input and insights invited from all students, faculty, and staff, a commission of Board of Trustee members, faculty, students, and staff led the development of the blueprint, titled *Abundance & Grace: A Blueprint for Flourishing in Faith & Hope*.

The strategic blueprint provides the substance for annual plans and assessments leading up to the 100th anniversary of the Seminary's 1927 move to Decatur, Georgia, and into Columbia's third century, beginning in 2028. It states that we aspire, through our strategic directions, to become an educational institution of theological inquiry and innovation that will:

- Build on Columbia Seminary's excellence in theological inquiry, critical thinking, and innovation, providing theological leadership for the Church and the world by educating and equipping faithful, imaginative, and effective pastoral leaders through degree and non-degree programs, contextual education, research, and lifelong learning.
- Expand on Columbia Theological Seminary's residential campus, developing and implementing the framework for a campus culture of Christian worship, hospitality, and belonging that exists on our campus and extends translocally and globally.
- Enrich Columbia Theological Seminary's exemplary workplace culture, pursuing excellence in our policies, procedures, and practices, stewarding the Seminary's resources, and building mutually beneficial relationships with external partners at the local, regional, and global levels.
- Strengthen Columbia Theological Seminary's vision of inclusion and commitment to diversity by engaging, exploring, and facilitating the highest levels of institutional leadership and effectiveness, organizational justice, and future-oriented planning within an environment of transparent, shared governance as we join boldly in the new thing God is already doing among us.

The Board of Trustees voted unanimously to approve the Blueprint. Now, the Seminary is in the implementation process. "Columbia approaches theological education as an enterprise in the formation of the whole person, both within and outside the classroom," affirms President Ayolo. "The Strategic Blueprint will guide the way we accomplish this mission."

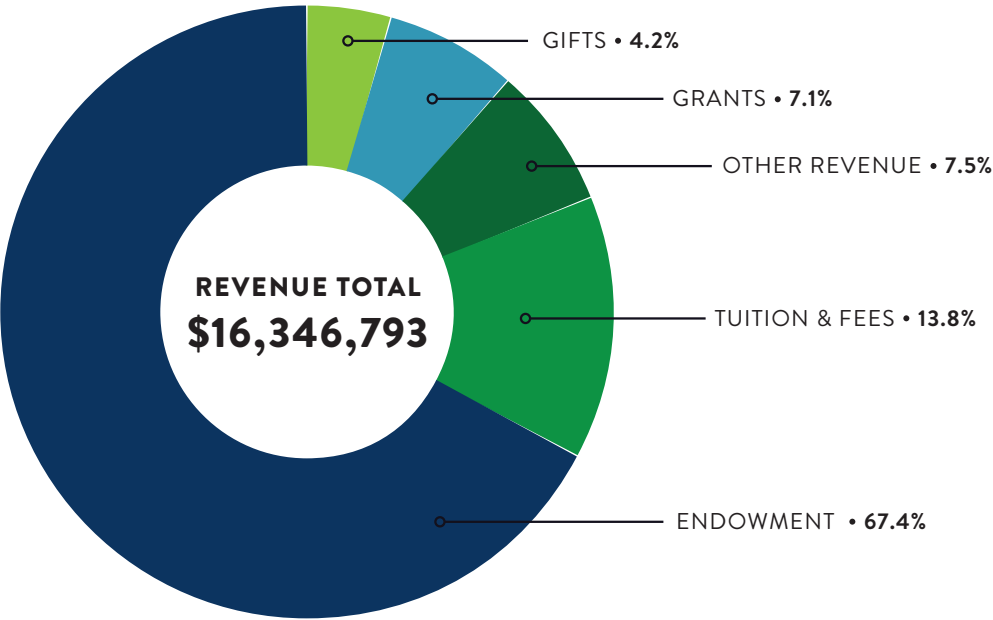

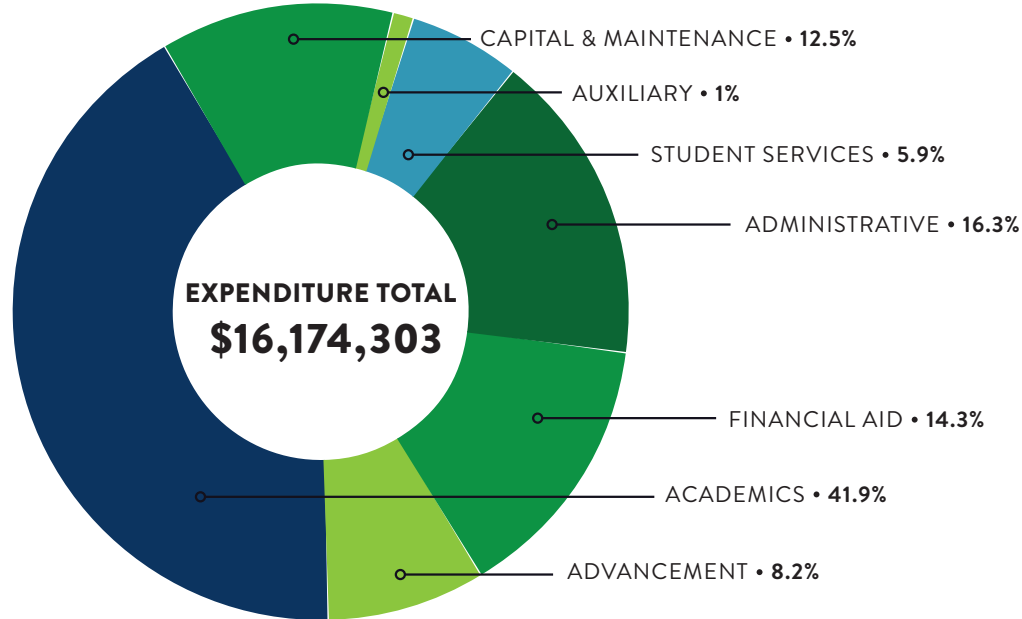

Gifts and grants made during fiscal year 2022-2023, alongside proceeds from endowments established over many years, brought forth a combined donor impact of 83% of Columbia's operating revenue. More than four out of every five dollars Columbia spent to fulfill its mission this year came from the abundance and grace of faithful donors, past and present.

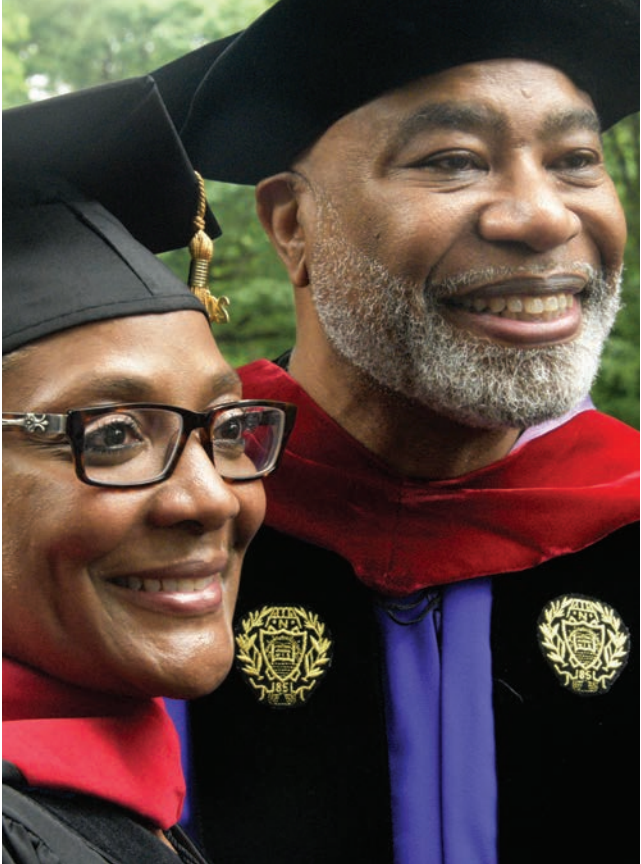

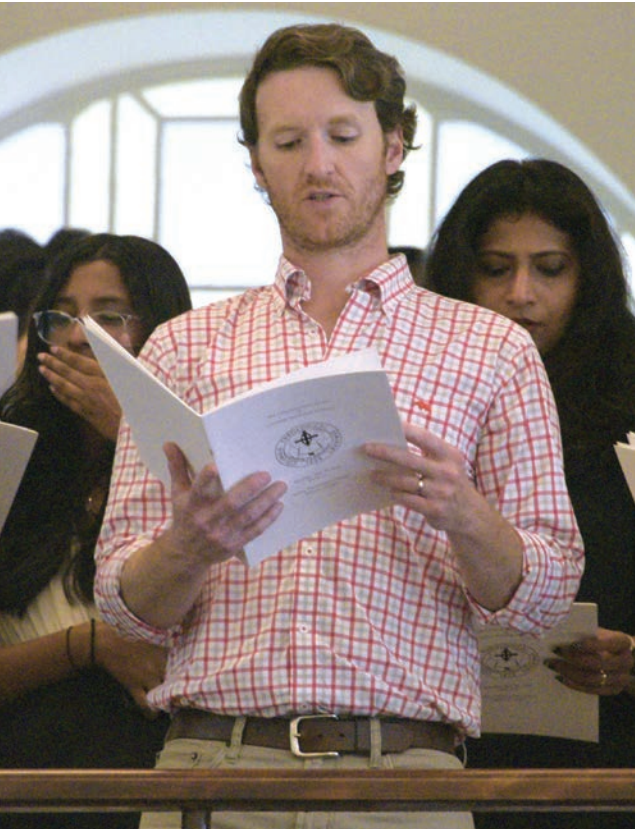

The Reverend Colonel Mary Lou (Morris) and Colonel Donald Martin Kollarik first met as officers in the U.S. Army. Following their military service, Mary Lou attended Emory University’s Candler School of Theology and was ordained as a United Methodist minister in the North Georgia Conference UMC. Meanwhile, Don regularly volunteered at Emory University Hospital and was a member of “The Sing-Alongs,” which supported three Alzheimers facilities in Atlanta. As Mary Lou went on to serve as pastor in charge at several churches, the two spent most of their lives together devoted to Christian service. They were married for 53 years until Mary Lou’s death on January 4, 2023.

The Colonels Kollarik have established scholarship endowments at the Smeal College of Business at The Pennsylvania State University, Winthrop University, and the Candler School of Theology at Emory University. Now, in memory of his wife and their shared commitment to national and Christian service, Don Kollarik has established an endowment at Columbia Theological Seminary. # BUILDING COMMUNITY AND INSPIRING SPIRITUAL TRANSFORMATION: THE DOCTOR OF MINISTRY JUSTICE TRACK

Dr. Mitzi Smith and Dr. Bill Brown taught in the first course for the first cohort of the newly launched Justice track within the Doctor of Ministry degree program, co-teaching a new course titled "Biblical Perspectives of Justice."

The two instructors could not have been more different. Dr. Smith is a Black, womanist New Testament scholar, while Dr. Brown is a white, male, privileged Old Testament scholar. Likewise, the cohort brought together a diverse group of black and white pastors and administrators, both women and men, as well as a pastor from Myanmar.

The result? A highly generative, challenging, community-building, and spiritually transforming class.

The class critically and contextually explored a wide range of texts and their contexts raising awareness about injustice in our world and exploring how both justice and injustice are characterized in biblical texts. Reading this content through the lens of intersectionality, the class aimed to understand how systems of oppression overlap and converge, harming both individuals and their communities.

Knowing that trauma must be voiced and heard for healing to take place, students constructed laments, some of which are excerpted on this page. May they embolden us "to do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly with God."
